Suspect(s): Steve Smith (37 years), Porterville resident

Narrative:

On February 12, 2010, at approximately 8:18 AM, a Porterville Police Department Officer made consensual contact with a subject, identified as Steve Smith (37 years), in the area of Morton Avenue and Prospect Street. Smith was found to be wanted by CDC Parole and was a Parolee at Large. After his arrest, Smith was found to be in possession of a small amount of methamphetamine, as well as a credit card in a female's name determined to be the victim of a burglary several months ago. Smith was also found to be under the influence of a controlled substance and in possession of controlled substance paraphernalia. Smith was arrested for being a wanted Parolee, being in possession of stolen property, methamphetamine, and controlled substance paraphernalia, and being under the influence of a controlled substance. Smith was booked at the Tulare County Sheriff's Department Porterville substation where he is being held without bail. This case is still under investigation.
