**Incident:** 664 - 460 PC – Attempted Burglary of an Inhabited Dwelling

**Date/Time:** July 23, 2010, 12:58 A.M.

**Location:** Sub 100 Block of North Wisconsin Street

**Suspect:** Bryan Auld, 25 years, Porterville resident

**Narrative:**

On July 23, 2010 at 12:58 A.M., Officers of the Porterville Police Department responded to the Sub 100 Block of North Wisconsin Street, for reports of an interrupted residential burglary. The confidential victim reported she was awakened by the sound of someone attempting to remove the screen from the front window of her residence. While conducting the investigation, Officers observed a subject, later identified as Bryan Auld, running near the victim's residence. Officers followed Auld, who entered a nearby residence and eventually located him hiding inside a bedroom closet. Auld was detained and found to have three warrants for his arrest, two of which were felony warrants. Auld was taken into custody without incident. Through evidence and statements obtained during his apprehension, it was determined that Auld was responsible for tampering with the victim's window. Auld was booked into the custody of the Tulare County Sheriffs Office on the aforementioned charges.
