**Summary:**

On March 23, 2010 at approximately 11:55 A.M. Porterville Police Officers were dispatched to Payless Shoes located at 1311 West Henderson Avenue regarding two females who had stolen shoes and fled in a vehicle. A vehicle description was provided to responding officers which was located a short time later by a state parole agent. The vehicle was stopped in the 900 block of West Lybarger and the occupants were contacted, identified as Sandra Alvarado and Destany McCloud. Alvarado was found to be on active State parole and a subsequent search of her vehicle revealed the stolen shoes. Officers also located several other clothing items that still had the tags on them. Further investigation revealed that both suspects had also entered Target and Pine Tree and stolen several items of clothing. Both Target and Pine Tree officials were unaware of the thefts until contacted by officers. All property was recovered and returned and both suspects were booked into the Tulare County Jail on 3 counts of commercial burglary, possession of stolen property and conspiracy. Alvarado was additionally charged with parole violation.
