Narrative:

On March 11, 2010 at 11:27 P.M., Officers of the Porterville Police Department responded to the Brick House Bar and Grill, regarding reports of unwanted patrons. Officers contacted one of the confidential victims, who reported he was struck in the face by one of the suspects, Annalee Valdez, while she was being escorted off the premises. The confidential victim further reported during the incident, an associate of Valdez', Bonafacio Rosas, threatened to shoot him and the other confidential victim while making gang related slurs.

Officers located Rosas and Valdez at their residence and a brief struggle ensued when Officers attempted to detain Valdez, although Rosas was taken into custody without incident. Valdez was booked into the custody of the Tulare County Sheriffs Office on a charge of Delaying / Obstructing a Peace Officer and Rosas was booked on felony charges of Criminal Threats and being a Participant of a Criminal Street Gang.
