Incident: Criminal threats
Resisting arrest

Date/Time: 4-9-10/ 3:00 PM

Location: 2300 Block W. Henderson Avenue, Porterville

Suspect(s): Jaime Cortes (36 years), Porterville resident

Narrative:

On April 9, 2010, at approximately 2:00 PM, Porterville Police Department Officers were dispatched to the 700 block of N. Plano Street, to meet with a female victim of criminal threats. Once determining that the felony crime had occurred, officers responded to the suspect's residence in an attempt to locate him. The male suspect, 36 year-old Jaime Cortes, was located in the front yard of his residence. Upon observing officers, Cortes fled on foot. Officers were able to catch Cortes, but he resisted arrest and a police K9 was utilized to assist in subduing him. Cortes was transported to Sierra View Hospital where he was treated for minor injuries sustained during the arrest. Cortes was booked at the Tulare County Jail for criminal threats and resisting arrest. He is being held in lieu of \$50,000.00 bail. This case is still under investigation.
