

End of Month/Sector 4/ June, 2010

A Sector 4 meeting was held at the police department on June 10, 2010. All of the officers assigned to Sector 4 were in attendance.

One of the topics discussed was trash dumping located along the Tule River. Officer Garcia advised he had located trash dumping along the river while conducting river patrol details with the Polaris. Officer Garcia will be looking into jurisdiction coordinate a clean-up effort.

Officer Orique had scheduled a sector meeting at 45 N. Salisbury Street, which was scheduled for June 26, 2010. Officer Orique attended the meeting on June 26, in which approximately 20 tenants attended. According to Officer Orique, the tenants had no major complaints and questioned the reason or need for the meeting. The tenants did praise the new managers, Joe and Clorisse Cappozzoli, advising they were doing a great job.

Officer Sutherland advised he had made contact with citizens belonging to the Neighborhood Watch program living in the area of the 2200 block of W. Orange Avenue. The complaint from the residents in the area was speeders east and westbound on Orange Avenue, most of which appearing to be undesirables. The residents requested the use of the speed trailer in the area. Officer Sutherland is coordinating with Sergeant Blankenship to arrange the use of the speed trailer in the area of Orange Avenue and Westwood Street.

On June 11, 2010, Officer Cooksey utilized the Polaris at the air show. Officer Garcia utilized the Polaris several times during night shift in the month of June to conduct Tule River patrol. Illegal dumping was the only thing noted during the patrol checks.

Captain Kroutil received a few calls on the hotline from someone complaining about suspicious activity

Detective Echevarria was recently contacted by the manager of 450 W. Springville Avenue. The manager voiced her concern of possible gang members walking through the complex at all hours of the day and night. The manager has requested extra patrol in the complex.

On June 15, 2010, I observed a vacant residence at 1410 W. Tomah Avenue. The yard of the residence was very overgrown and had weeds nearly to the roofline. I contacted Code Enforcement Officer Dignam and requested something be done about the eyesore.
